The venue is influenced by the southern hospitality of New Orleans, reflected in its beverages, food and, of course, music.

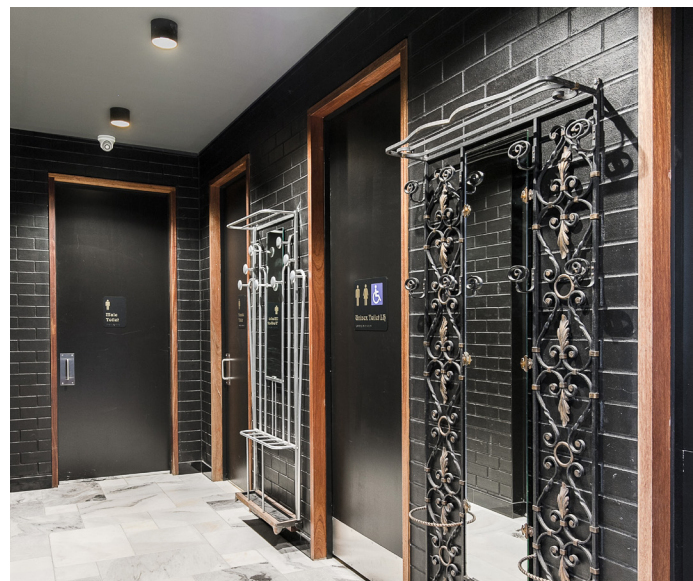
